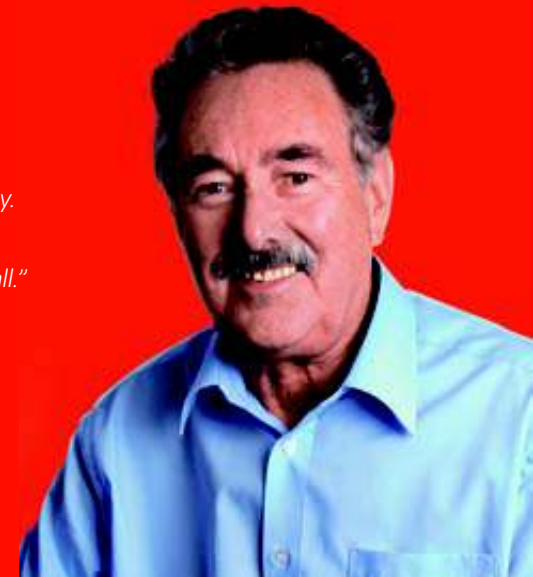

# Banbury Range

Banbury is the elite of our range. The design that offers you plenty of real extras which you'll appreciate all the more as the years go by. 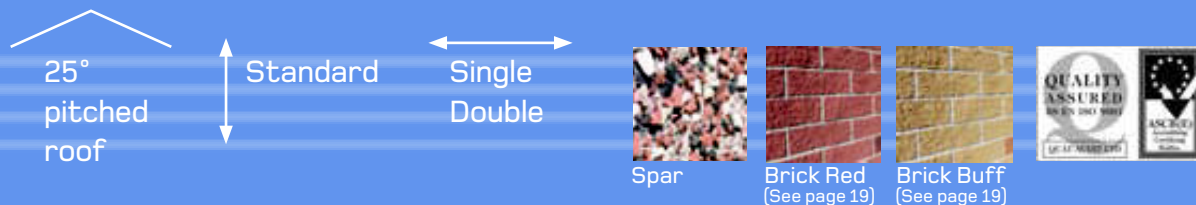
The more traditional 25° roof pitch is fully lined and topped with one of six tile colours. Maintenance-free features include white PVCu fascias and verge boards. Plus, the up-and-over door is plastisol coated to maintain Georgian-style elegance without you ever needing to pick up a paintbrush. The choice of four real brick front post finishes lend extra character.

Black PVCu guttering, a plastisol coated personnel door and a white PVCu double-glazed opening window with a lockable handle are further standard features.

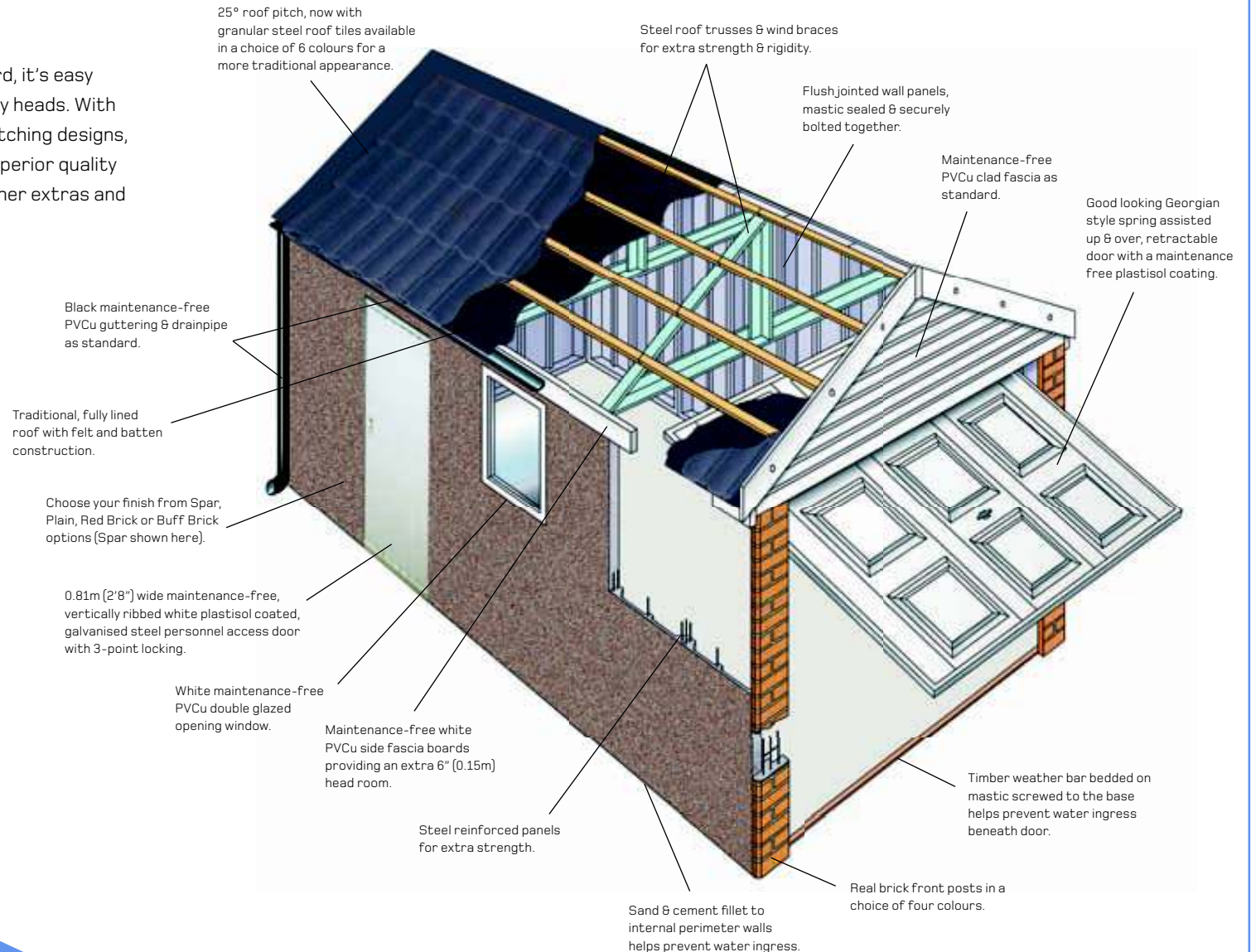

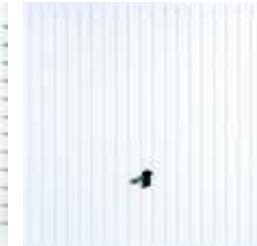
Up-and-over doors come with a 10-year warranty covering safe and reliable operation (provided they receive regular and recommended maintenance).

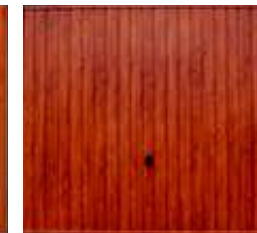

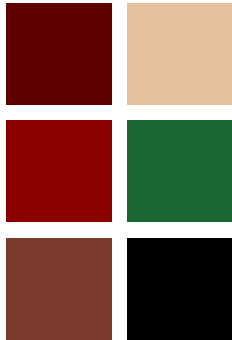

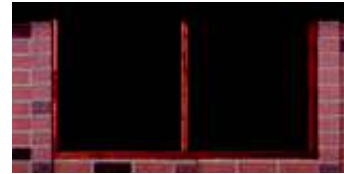
## A window of opportunity.

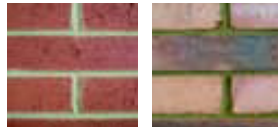

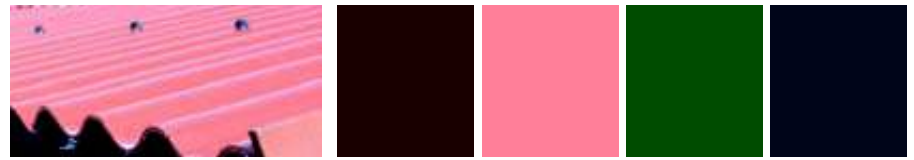

Cedar is an option on Apex garages, with PVCu, Golden Oak or Rosewood fascias suitable for both Apex and Banbury garages. White maintenance free plastisol is available for flat garages.

There are four colours of painted roof sheets. And six variations of granular steel roof tiles. Have natural light pouring in from above with translucent roof sheets available on Apex garages.

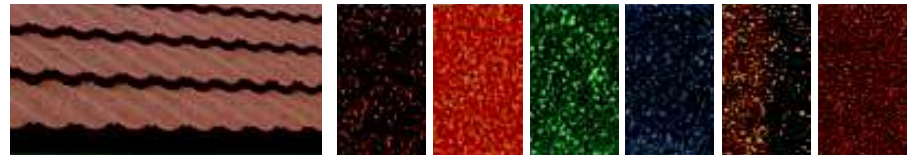

## Smarter storage.

To preserve the structural integrity of the pre-cast concrete (and your 10 year guarantee) drilling for shelving should be avoided. But thanks to our alternative options, you can still store a wide range of household items. The Shelf Stack is a six shelf unit that's screwed into brackets welded into the steel uprights and is delivered along with your building. Our 3-shelf pack is for any garage design and comes with brackets that are fitted using existing panel bolts. You can also order Garage Grids, a highly versatile system of hooks, brackets and baskets that you can arrange as you like.

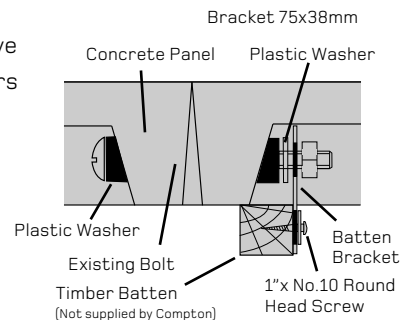

## Lining your garage.

Lining clips are supplied in a pack of twelve galvanised steel clips, screws and washers that enable timber bearers to be fixed vertically to line all or part of a building (minimum bearer depth 32mm (1¼"), batten supplied by others).

## Security options.

Compton garages have been designed with security in mind. The robust nature of their design and build quality ensures they offer strong protection against the threat of theft or vandalism. However there are further options available to increase security as follows:

### Windows

Drawing upon technology developed by Secured by Design, our double-glazed PVCu window range offers greater security than ordinary windows. You can further protect your goods with exclusive laminated glass. The tough outer pane is almost impossible to break giving you extra peace of mind.



### Doors

Compton has introduced four point secure locking on our up-and-over doors to give double the protection compared to standard doors. A key-operated secure handle makes it virtually impossible to break the lock on the door. It also has 10,000 different key combinations; a benefit also found on our 3-point locking steel personnel doors.



### Roofing

Our plastisol galvanised steel roof sheets (which also have an anti-condensation treatment) will deter even the most ardent burglar. The sheets are fixed to our roof purlins with special high security fixings, requiring a specialised tool to remove them. So the casual thief would simply be wasting their time.



# Preparing your garage base – do's and don'ts.

Compton builds for the long term. Therefore, it is wise to ensure your foundations are also designed for the long term, too. If in doubt, talk to your local Compton agent who will be able to give straightforward advice. In the meantime, here are a few tips to consider.

- ✓ Do use a local agent recommended service or a competent local builder.
- ✓ Do make sure your base is flat, square and level.
- ✓ Do build your base 152mm (6") wider and longer than the external dimensions of your building.
- ✓ Do ensure that the base stands proud of the surrounding ground so that water will not run on to the base.
- ✓ Do consider the type of soil (clay needs a different base design to sandy loam soil), and look at the proximity of trees, hedges and roots.

## Consider if you need approval.

Very few of the buildings in our range need local authority approval (such as Planning Permission or Building Regulation approval). Your local agent will advise, but only a letter from your local council can confirm if you need their permission to proceed. For further details see our Technical Information and Your Questions Answered brochures. If you are in any doubt talk to your local authority.

- ✓ Do consider putting in a damp course if you want to store anything inside your building.
- ✓ Do look up when marking out your base – remember that roof sheets and gutters overhang the wall, particularly important on a boundary.
- ✗ Don't construct your base from tarmac, paving slabs, paving blocks or any other material other than concrete.
- ✗ Don't build your base at a level lower than surrounding ground, or we cannot guarantee the performance of the sand and cement fillet.
- ✗ Don't build your base with a fall to the front – we provide a hardwood timber weather bar free of charge to prevent water and leaves blowing under your up and over door.
